2001 BOYS/GIRLS TRACK RULES

FOR RULES AND INFORMATION GOVERNING MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS, DUES, ID CARDS, POSTPONEMENTS, PROTESTS, RESIDENCE AND TRANSFER OF PARTICIPANTS, WAIVERS, QUESTIONNAIRES, FRANCHISE FEES, ROSTERS, FORFEITS, GAME OFFICIALS, AWARDS, BILLING, TIED LEAGUES, FINES, ELIGIBILITY, PLAY-OFFS OR GAME POINTS, REFER TO PGCBGC GROUND RULES AND DEFINITIONS (REV.4/00).

I. **AGE GROUPS**

Events for both boys and girls 7 and Under; 8 and Under; 9 and Under; 10 and Under; 11 and Under; 12 and Under; 13 & 14 and Under; 15 & 16 and Under; 17 & 18 and Under; with age divisions based on the age the child becomes BETWEEN January 1st and December 31st, 2001.

II. **QUESTIONNAIRES** -- Due on May 18, 2001.

III. **ROSTERS**

Refer to Ground Rules (Rev. 4/00) and the following:

- A. Due Date: May 18, 2001
- B. Roster close Date: June 6, 2001
- C. ID check: May 26 through June 6, 2001
- D. All players on rosters must present a valid ID card at the meet in order to participate in the PG County Boys/girls Club Track Program.

IV. **TRACK PROCEDURES**

- A. A child may be entered in only four events, including relays.
- B. Authorized persons are Judges, Timekeepers and Scorekeepers.
- C. Timekeepers and Foul Judges will be chosen from P.G. County High School Track Teams.
- D. A youth may participate in an older age group. If this occurs in an individual event, that athlete must participate in the older age bracket the entire meet. Younger athletes may move up with out penalty for RELAYS ONLY.
- E. In order to have speedy and orderly meets the following rules will be strictly enforced:
 - 1. Coaches will not be allowed in restricted areas.
 - 2. Legitimate track shoes (1/4" spikes) are optional.
 - 3. Some type of shoes must be worn (no barefeet).
- F. No Girls will be allowed to compete with the boys (exception -Relays.)
- G. No Boys will be allowed to compete with the girls (exception - Relays.)
- H. Girls and Boys may combine on relay teams as long they do not exceed the number of events (See IV.A.)

2001 BOYS/GIRLS TRACK RULES CONT'D

V. CONDUCT

Conduct is the coach's responsibility. ONLY authorized personnel will be allowed on the field. Any ineligible person on the field will result in forfeiture. A designated area will be assigned to each club and it is the coach's responsibility to keep his team in this area.

VI. POSTPONEMENTS

In case of rain or wet field, the RAINDATE will be TBA

VII. INELIGIBLE PLAYERS

- A. Refer to PGCBGC Ground Rules (Rev. 4/00).
- B. An ineligible member in any event will result in forfeiture and further disciplinary action may be taken.

VIII. AWARDS

No team trophies will be awarded. Trophies will be given for 1st, 2nd, 3rd place in each event, and ribbons for 4th, 5th, and 6th place.

IX. COST OF AWARDS

The cost of trophies and ribbons for the track meet will be equally shared by all participating clubs. Bills will be mailed to each Club after the meet.
